



Arizona Electronic Health Record Collaborative Purchasing Program

The **Arizona Electronic Health Record (EHR) Collaborative Purchasing Program**, led by AHCCCS, is designed to help providers in small and medium-sized practices who would like to go electronic, but haven't found (or don't have the time to look for) an affordable, low-hassle EHR solution.

The Arizona Collaborative Purchasing Program (CPP) plans to feature a CCHIT **Certified, web-based Electronic Health Record** including

- Clinical notes (medical history, problem list, SOAP notes)
- E-Prescribing (medication list, allergies, interactions, formularies, refills)
- E-Referrals (Continuity of Care Record (CCR), attachments)
- Interfaces with lab, radiology, hospital, and other key service providers
- Standard and ad-hoc reporting modules (quality measures, EPSDT, Medical Home, etc.)
- Practice management (financial and administrative modules optional)
- Eligibility verification
- Patient portal

Participants in the Collaborative Purchasing Program (CPP) will be eligible for:

- Discounted monthly subscription (less than \$500 per fulltime provider-based on total number of participating providers and features)
- Group purchase rates for hardware, software, interfaces, maintenance & support services
- Help with planning, selection, set-up, training, implementation and policies
- Tiered discounts and arrangements for part-time providers and students
- Facilitated user forum
- Contract management and expedited issues resolution

All Arizona providers are eligible for participation. Preference will be given to active AHCCCS registered providers who have completed and returned the *Interest Form* by December 31, 2008 <http://www.azhealthrecord.com/InterestForm/Default.aspx>
